DAY 1 22-12-2017,

Friday

On 22nd December, 2017 Friday as the part of National Service Scheme, Seven day camp was held at St. Catherines Higher Secondary School, Payyampally, Wayanad. NSS volunteers from the first year and second year participated in the programme with high enthusiasm. At 9.30 am NSS volunteers gathered in the seminar hall for the registration purpose of 7 day Camp. The volunteers started their journey from the college premises in two buses at 10 am. The destination was really far away from the college, Wayanad, called the princess of hills and beauty of nature accordingly. Seemed the best place for a perfect camp. Enjoying each and every bit of its beauty the volunteers reached at the Mananthavadi Govt UP School by 12.30 pm. The programme was organized by the Manathavadi Municipality in association with the NSS volunteers of Mary Matha Arts and Science College, Mananthavadi, and NAM College, Kallikkandy. Mahatma Gandhi University and Kannur University joined their hands together for the project "Jaivam" held by Kerala Government . Jaivam, a program conducted in every districts of kerala. At 2.30pm the students from 2 colleges conducted a rally at the town of Mananthavadi Municipality raising slogans on the awareness on starting the new project of kerala Government named Jaivam. The Area Committee chairperson presided the inauguration ceremony. The Inauguration was done by Sri. Ramachandran sir, who gave a wonderful idea on different types of farming and its cultivation in various ways. By giving the vote of thanks the inauguration ceremony came to an end. By 4.15 pm the bus reached the campsite with all the volunteers. After reaching the destination, the volunteers were provided with tea and went to their allocated rooms. By 8'O clock Dr. M.K.Madhusoodhanan conducted an Ice breaking session for NSS volunteers. He gave his maximum effort to encourage us, it was a complete success that the volunteers were thrilled and showed their skills. He divided the volunteers into 5 groups and conducted some special programmes. Firstly, everyone was assigned the work of setting up the centre stage of all the activity meant to be done all the seven days. All the volunteers came to know each other by this session. By 11 pm, the session came to an end. After having the dinner the day ended.

DAY 2 23-12-2017,

Saturday

The thrill and josh of our volunteers and whose motto to do service with the tagline "not me but you" flew through the epicenter of Payyampally village. With the wind breeze all around the campsite there came the second day of Seven days NSS Camp, on 23rd December 2017. Around 2.30 everyone had their lunch and returned back to the camp venue. At sharp 5.00 pm all the volunteers reached at the seminar hall to attend the session led by Sri. Ashraf sir of NAM College. DAY 3 24-12-2017,

Sunday

As Wayanad is one of the major hill stations in India, the camp experienced a tough weather condition with a temperature of 15 degree Celsius. The day started at 5.30am. Afreed was the day officer of the third day of the camp ie. 24 December 2017. As a new day the volunteers were expecting more from the previous day. Each day is a fresh beginning for all. Team Jazparaou given the duty of cleaning and controlling of the food committee. Around 6.00 am Jazparaous members started making breakfast. All the volunteers except the Jazparaou team woke up at 6.30 am and had their tea at 6.45 am. Plum cakes were distributed with the hot tea as it was the gift sponsored by Sri. Anusree. Then after the assembly and newspaper report everyone went to do the daily exercise. At sharp 8.30, breakfast was distributed and by 9.15 am every volunteers were ready for the survey. The villagers also joined hands together with the volunteers to make the Christmas night an awesome experience. After that there came another session of cultural programs where the volunteers had to show their skills on the spot. It was one fantastic experience to everyone as it includes a Speech which was like the spitting of fire. At the end of the program, there was an evaluation session. One member from each group evaluated the day. After 12 o clock there started a new day, the day of Christmas. Another surprise came in the form of Santa Claus. Senior NSS volunteer was the Santa. He sang songs and danced with the volunteers. Also there was a cake cutting ceremony sponsored by the College Union. After the distribution everyone went for dinner and the lights got turned off for the next day.

DAY 4 25-12-2017,

Monday
