DAY 1(15-03-2021)

Day 1 (15.03.2021) : Planning for the camp was done on 15.03.2021. The NSS Units 31 and 32 of NAM College, Kallikkandy organized a virtual special camp from 15.03.2021 to 21.03.2021. 101 students attended the virtual camp and were facilitated by five teachers. The camp was organized by Dr. Abdul Gafoor CV, the Programme Officer of Unit Nos. 31 and was supported by, Musthafa KS, the Programme Officer of unit 32.

The camp was inaugurated by Prof. **Veerankutty-** Retired Malayalam Professor and Poet. The Icebreaking session and group formation handled by Musthafa KS. Instructions and camp rules explained by Dr. Abdul Gafoor CV. First day camp closed after the cultural program at 9.30 pm.





DAY 2 (16-03-2021)

The second day program started at 7.30 am with NSS song. Then Yoga, Thought of the Day speech, digital paper presentation and evaluation of the previous day program were completed as per the Day 2 schedule. The Day's notable activity was 'Shramadan' (Cleaning in and around the houses of volunteers and neighborhood or locality (Offline). In the afternoon there was a n awareness session by Dr. Efthikar Ahmed, Assistant Professor of English, Central University of Kerala, on the topic 'The Role of Youth in Pandemic Situations. In addition, there was a vocal presentation by DJ Adarsh, Kerala's first beatboxer. At 9.30 pm, camp day 2 closed after cultural programs by students.



DAY 3 (17-03-2021)

Day 3 began as usual with NSS song, Thought of the Day, digital paper presentation, and evaluation of the previous day activities. Third day major activity was Gardening/ Planting in the premises of Volunteers Own house gardens. In the late evening there was an interesting session by **Mr.Asees Nallaveetil** on the topic 'ECALOGICOUCIO'. The day session closed at 10 pm after cultural programme.



DAY 4 (18-03-2021)

The fourth day after the routine activities students continued the previous day gardening activity as per the schedule till 12.30 pm.
