DAY 1 (24 December 2021)

The first day of 7 days NSS Special Camp 'Othorumichu' was started with an official inauguration function. Mrs.Shameena KP, Thriprangottur Grama Panchayath Health and Education Standing Committee Chairperson, inaugurated function was presided over by Dr.Mohammed Kutty Kakakkunna, College Principal. Mr.Sameer Parambath(Working Secretary, Management Committee) , Mr.Ali Kuyyalil (College Junior Superintendent) and Mr.

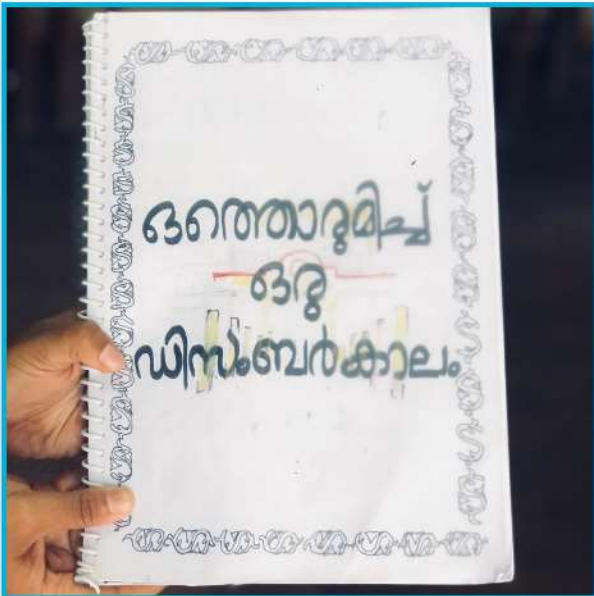
At 7 pm volunteers performed various cultural activities. After camp evaluation and dinner at 10 pm, volunteers enjoyed the camp fire at the end.
