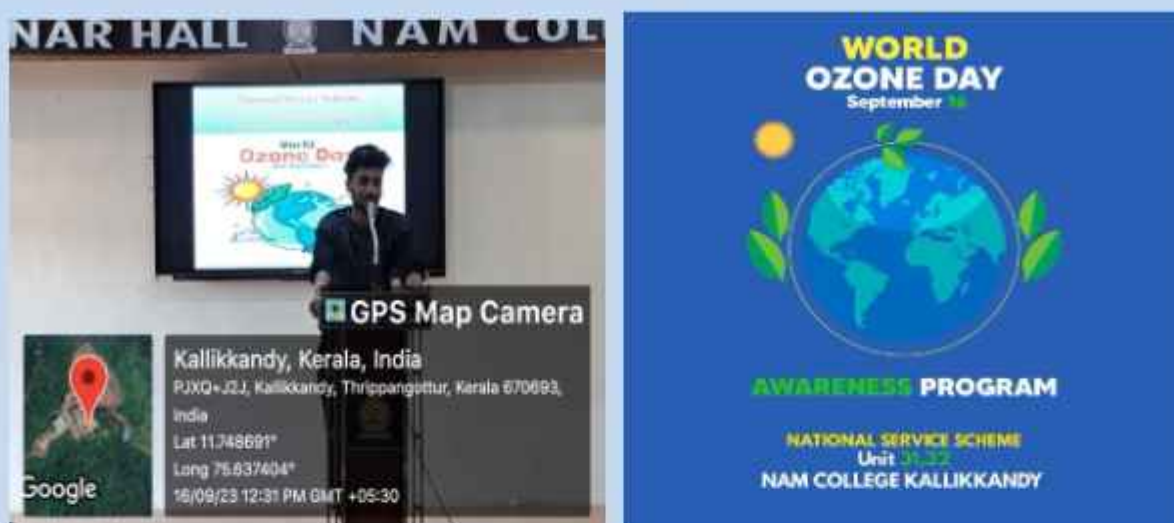
BLOOD DONATION CAMP – 15 SEPTEMBER

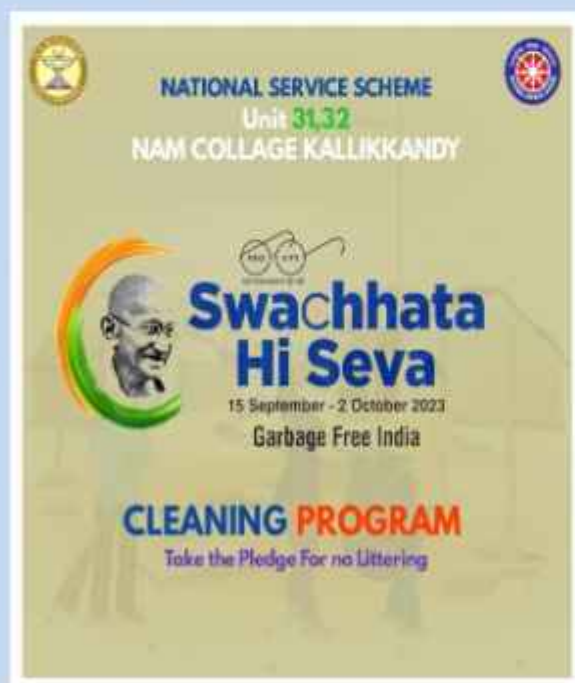
OZONE DAY CELEBRATION – 16 SEPTEMBER

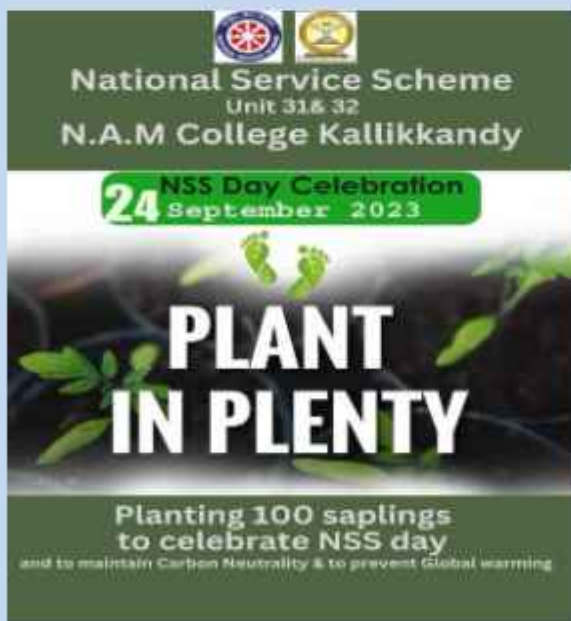
ANTI DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAMME – 23 SEPTEMBER

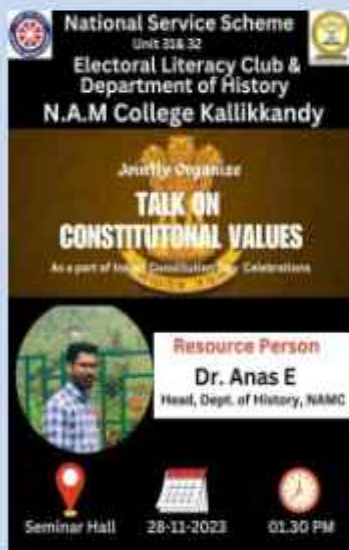


CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION - NOVEMBER 27 & 28

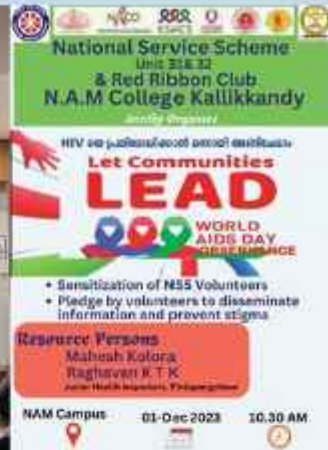

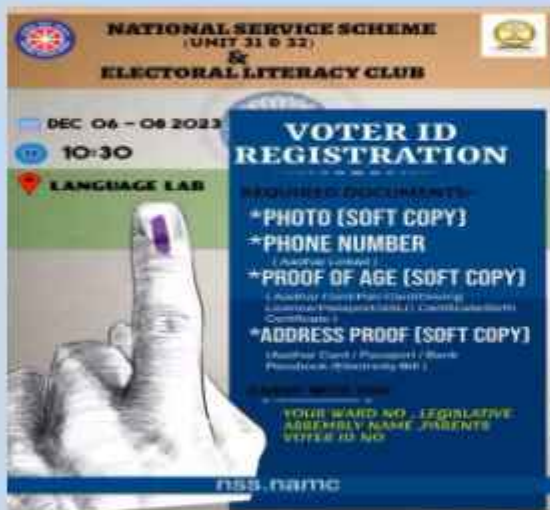
AIDS DAY AWARENESS PROGRAMME - DECEMBER 1
