



One Day Seminar on Research Methodology




Mathematics Association Inauguration



Mr Nasrulla, Department of English, provided materials for Paper - II (English). Post Graduate Students from different departments were the beneficiaries of the course.






The career guidance and placement Cell reminds the students about the important Employment Notifications in the government sector. Class based motivation session are also the part of the programme.


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WEBINAR ON 'WELLNESS IN WOMEN'S LIFE'






As part of women's day celebration the students performed a flash mob on 09.03.2022. Various slogans and messages regarding women empowerment were held up by the students during their performance.






Lecture on Education Research and IPR
