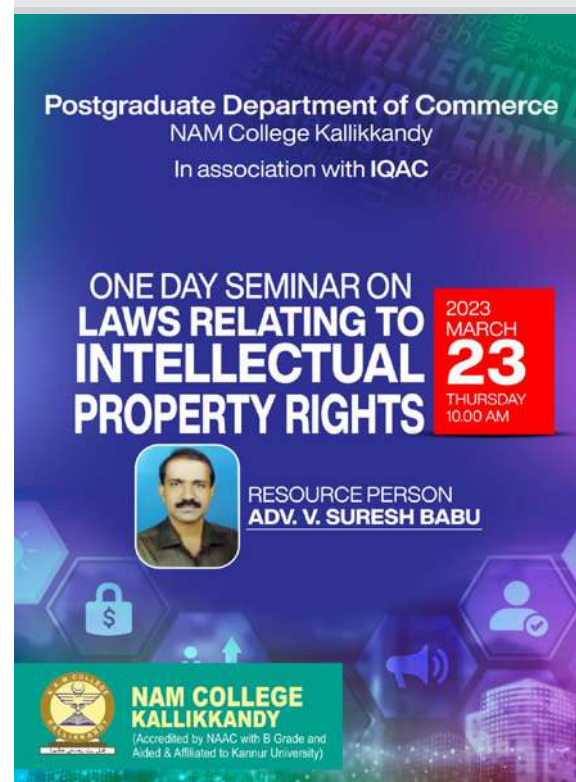


# ‘Laws Relating to Intellectual Property Rights’

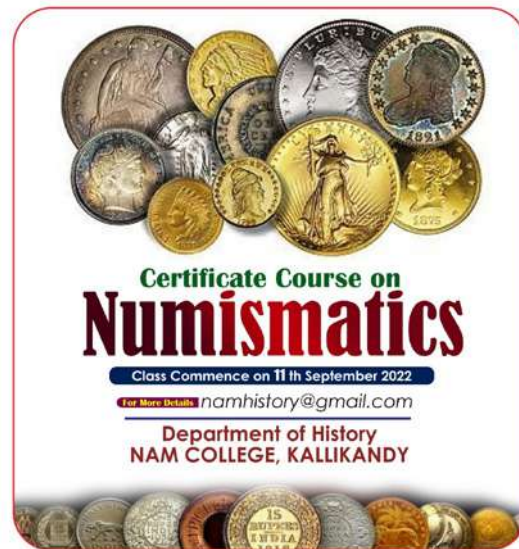

## LOL (Little Open Library)

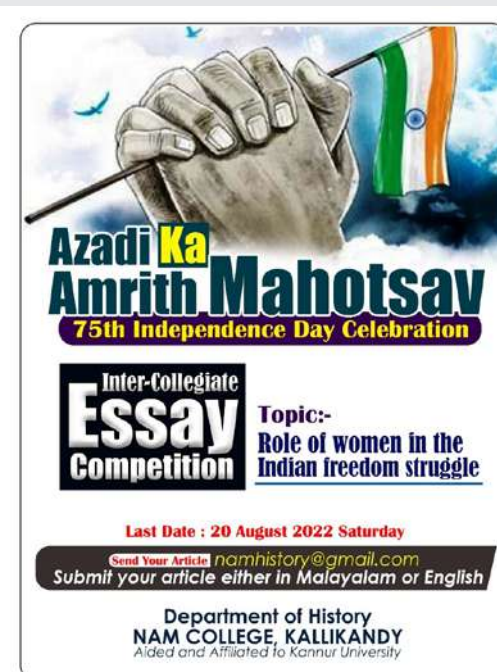


The Department of History has started a new (initiative) as LOL. The intention of this initiative is to make the special days of the students memorable by contributing books to

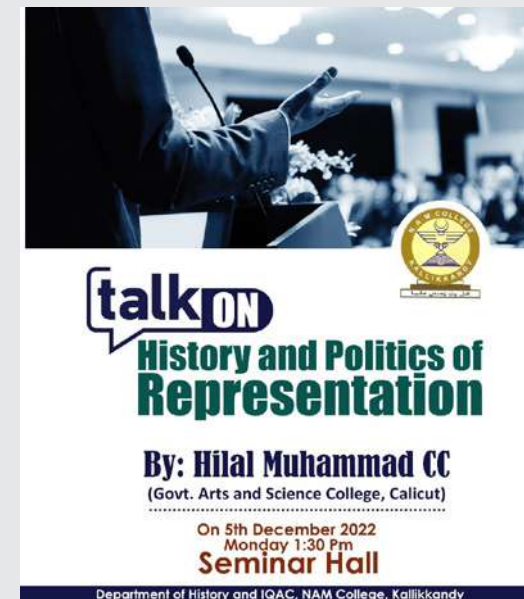

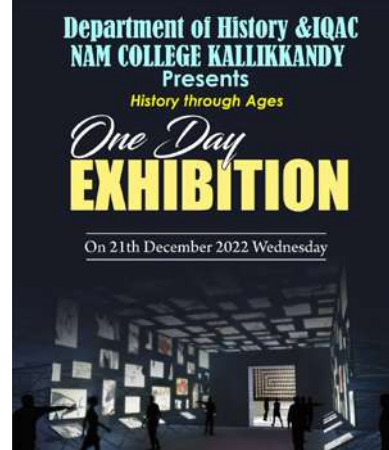
## Human Rights Day Observance

## One Day Exhibition

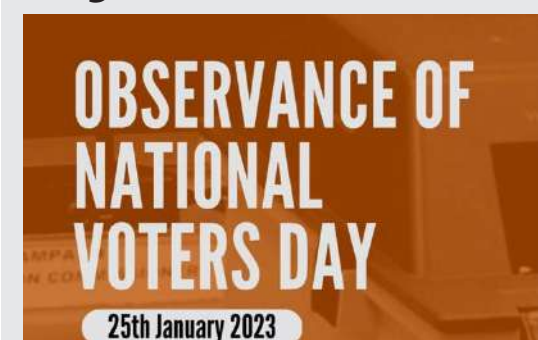

## Design Thinking for an Innovative Ecosystem in Campus

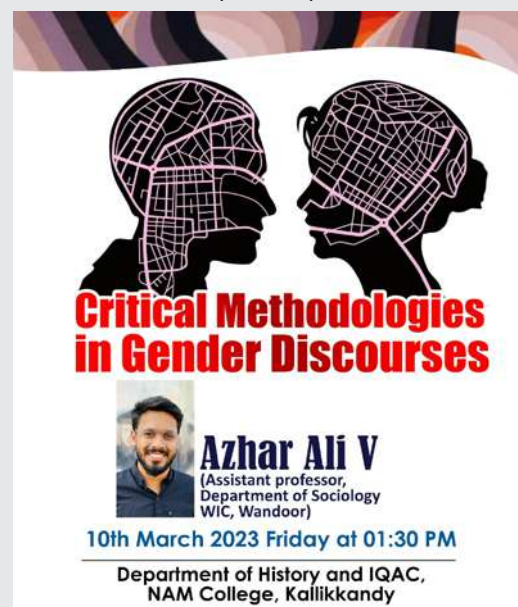

The resource person also spoke about the components of a theory in research and stressed on the importance of review of literature.

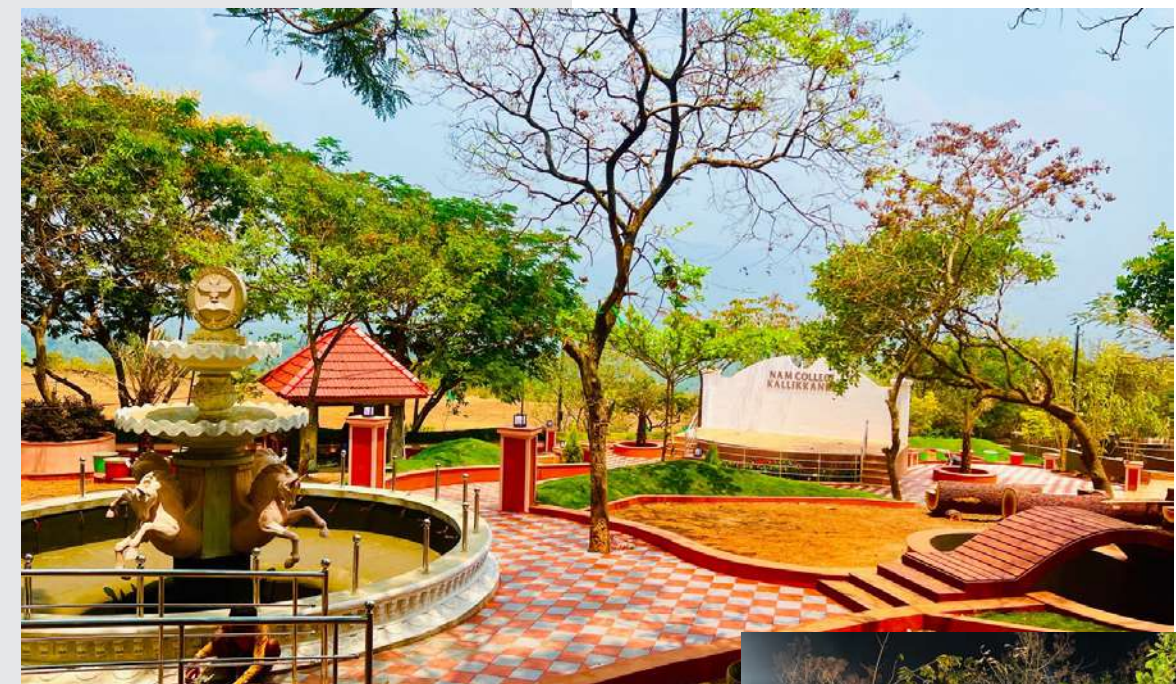

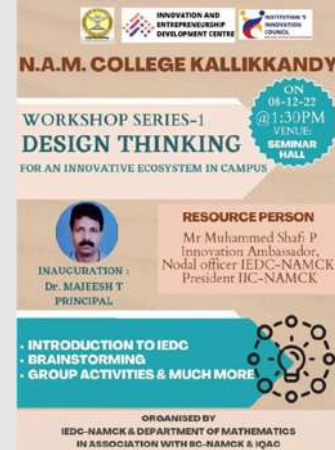

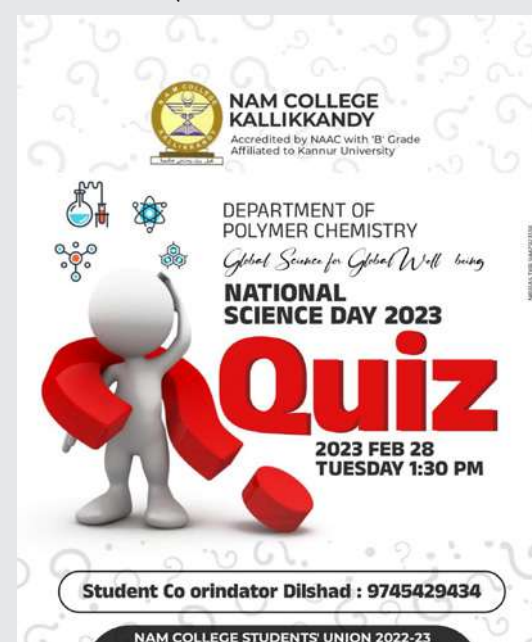


# National Science Day Celebration

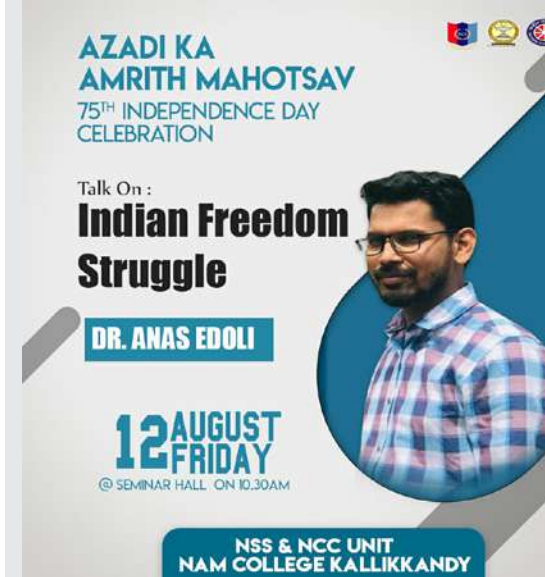

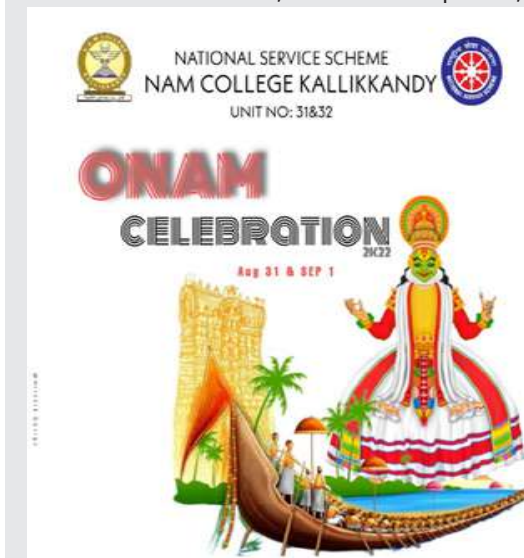

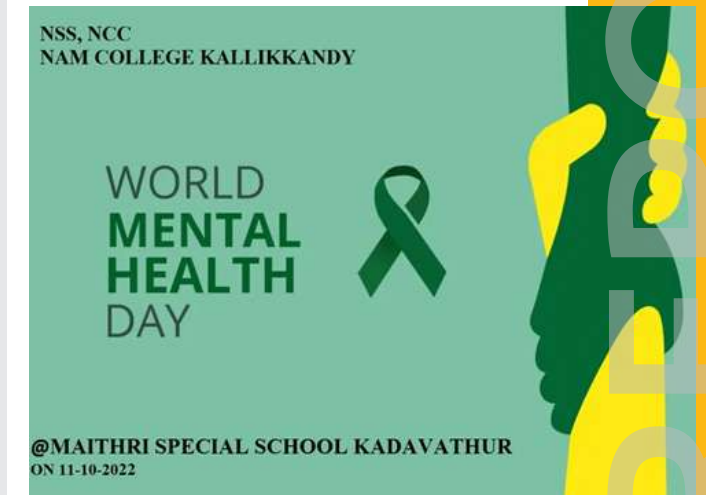
