2.3 Teaching-Learning Process

2.3.1 Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences using ICT tools

Response:

The key objective of our college is to implement an effective teaching-learning process via continuous and conscious efforts to enable the students to realize their potential and evolve as leaders and transforming agents of society. The college provides an effective platform for students to develop their skills, knowledge, values, attitude etc. to shape their behaviour in the desired manner. Experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies are well adopted to ensure the overall progress of students. The major student centric methods adopted in our college are given bellow.

Experiential learning and participative learning

- Practical classes / laboratory methods are conducted in all science programmes to help students experience the facts and principles that they study in their theory classes.
- All departments conduct certificate courses and addon courses to support students in experimental as well as comprehensive learning.
- To get direct learning experience, Science departments regularly conduct industrial visits and field trips to major chemical, industrial and technologically important firms and laboratories
- The department of History follows observative learning methods by conducting filed trips to various historical and excavation sites, to enable students to understand the historical importance of the places and people. The students are asked to prepare a project report of their visit to historical places.

Team work, seminar presentation, group discussion, case analysis etc. are practised among the students to ensure participative teaching learning methods.

Project and Problem-solving methods

Project method is encouraged among students of all the departments to stimulate freedom of thought and free exchange of different views and it is an essential component in the university curriculum also.

- The students participate in the teaching-learning process through questions— answers sessions, a Quiz, brainstorming sessions and debates etc.
- Students' classroom interactions are augmented by giving problems after the each completion of topic. The solved problems are analysed in the classrooms by the teachers.

• Students are motivated to join various courses and to participate in various inter collegiate and intra collegiate technical fests and other activities such as quizes, debates, presentations etc.

ICT enabled classes

• All faculty members in the college use ICT & E-resources, in addition to the chalk and board method, to enhance the quality of the teaching learning process. The following are the tools recently employed in our institution:
